Time: Coaches meeting will be held at 4:00 pm in the press box. Field events will begin at 4:15 pm and running events will begin at 4:45 pm.

Entries: Meet will be time by Accurace Timing. To register for this event, go online to accuracetime.com and find the Pirate Invitational on the upcoming events list. Click on the Direct Athletics link on this meet to take you to the online entry platform. All entries will be due no later than 6:00 pm on Sunday, April 22nd.

Entries will be limited to 3 entries in each individual event and one relay team, with the exception of pole vault where the limit will be 2 entries each for both boys and girls.

Order of Events: We will follow the WIAA order of events

Boys Discus Followed by Girls

Girls Long Jump Followed by Boys (4:15 to 5:45 and 6:00 to 7:30, will run earlier if possible)

Boys Triple Jump Followed by Girls (4:15 to 5:45 and 6:00 to 7:30, will run earlier if possible)

Girls Shot Put Followed by Boys

Boys Pole Vault Followed by Girls

Boys and Girls High Jump will run concurrently with girls being on the finish line side pit (TBD)

Athletes will receive three (3) throws in the shot put and discus and three (3) jumps in the long and triple jump. No finals will be held. WIAA season regulations will govern all competition in the vertical jumps. Pole Vault and High Jump opening heights will be determined at the coaches' meeting.

Facility: The track is an 8 lane Fisher Track. ¼ inch pyramid spikes may be used on the track, on all runways, and jumping surfaces. Tape is not allowed on any of the surfaces. Chalk will be provided for athletes to mark starting points.

Scoring: NFHS scoring will be used for a eight (8) team meet. Individual events will be score at a 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1 basis, scoring the top 8 places. Relay events will be scored 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1, scoring the top 8 places.

Additional Information: Admission for this meet will be \$4 for adults and \$1 for students, with under 6 being free. The team entry fee total for boys and girls combined is \$140. Buses are asked to park around the back side of the school in the marked off area. Concessions will be available for purchase. Please keep team camps outside the track in the designated area next to 100 and hurdle starting line. Athletes should not be warming up in the infield area.

Awards: 1st through 3rd place medals will be awarded with 4th – 8th generic medals.
