*****WIAA Sectional Fee (As approved by the WIAA)**

All participating schools must pay a sectional entry fee to Albany High School. \$25 entry fee for each school's boys' and girls' teams (\$25/gender for a total of \$50 per school). In the event a team doesn't field a full team ~ less than 5 participants, the cost will be \$5 per individual runner. Make checks to *Albany High School*.

Directions to the Baertschi Farm Cross-Country Course:

From Madison - Take Park Street exit and go south on Hwy 14. Take the Hwy 138 exit in Oregon. Take a right on 138. Turn left on Cty MM between Kwik Trip and Stop-n-Go. Take Cty MM through Brooklyn. Once you have gone straight at the stop sign in Brooklyn, you will be on Hwy 104. Stay on 104 until you hit a stop sign, which will intersect on a curve with Hwy 59. Go straight at the stop sign ¼ mile, then take a right on Dunphy Road. (Road will be marked) The cross country course is approximately 3 miles on Dunphy Road on both sides of the road. Dunphy Rd. from the Madison direction will be detoured at 10:45am. (15 minutes before the first race) If you are traveling before 10:45am, there won't be any detour.

From Monroe -If you are traveling east on Hwy 11, take the Hwy 59 exit for Monroe. Take a left at the stop sign and follow Hwy 59 to Albany. Once you get to Albany, stay on Hwy 59 through Albany and take a left on Cty E (just past the Albany Mini-Mart). Stay on Cty E for one mile and turn right on Dunphy Road (Road will be marked). Course is on Dunphy Road approximately one mile.
