The WIAA Division 3 Sectional #5 will be held at Westby High School on Saturday, October 25, 2014. Schools participating include: Aquinas, Arcadia, Bangor, Blair-Taylor, Brookwood, Cashton, Cochrane-Fountain City, Hillsboro, Independence/Gilmanton, LaFarge/Kickapoo, Lincoln, Luther, Melrose-Mindoro, Necedah, New Lisbon, Osseo-Fairchild, Providence Academy, Westby, and Whitehall

Entries: Entries should be put into PTTiming. The link is: www.pttiming.com. I have attached PTTiming instructions if you need them. Deadline for entries is 11:59 pm on Tuesday, Oct. 21st.

****Reminder that each school is required by the WIAA to send entry fees for sectionals. The fees are \$25 per gender, \$50 per school (boys and girls), or if there are less than 5 on a team it is only \$5 per runner. Please make checks payable to Westby High School, attn: Andy Hulst AD.

****Admission for spectators will be \$5.00 per person.

The course opens for inspection @ 9:00 am. The meet schedule is as follows:

- 12:15 pm - Girls Race
- 1:00 pm - Awards Presentation (Finish Line)

GENERAL NOTES

1. Please pick up your meet packets at the tent near bus parking lot.
2. Coaches will receive special instructions from the WIAA with respect to how entries are to be handled
3. Spikes may be worn and will be checked by the Starter and may not exceed ½" in length.
4. Mile markers will be posted and splits read.
5. Accurace Timing Service will be working the meet - We will have regular bib numbers, no chips.
6. Starting Lanes have been assigned according to WIAA's random draw. Lane assignment will be as follows:

7. Restricted areas are designated where no one except appropriate competing athletes/meet personnel are allowed. These include, but are not limited to: starting line, parts of the race course, and finish chute.
8. A Jury of Appeals will handle any disputes. This committee will consist of Ralph Mann and Mark Dahl (WIAA Officials), Brian Huebner (Meet Manager), Kevin Liske (Onalaska Luther Head Coach), and Mindy Waddell (Brookwood Head Coach).
9. WIAA guidelines will be enforced with respect to uniforms, equipment, communication devices, starting procedure, etc. Please refer to the WIAA website for details on the Cross Country Tournament Series.
10. Team buses/vans may drop teams and team supplies at the front of the high school. Buses will be allowed to park in the high school parking lot while spectators will park in the middle school parking lot.
11. Team tents allowed but must be placed in a designated area. This area is primarily on the practice football field next to the finish line.
12. Concession and T-shirts will be sold on site.
13. Restrooms: There will be 2 portable toilets located at the starting line and 2 near the finish line. In the event of an emergency, we will be able to access the school; please find Andy Hulst or Karl Stoker if this happens.
