Darlington Invitational Track Meet Monday, April 22, 2019 – 4:00 PM

Schools Participating: Albany, Benton/Scales Mound/Shullsburg, Black Hawk, Dodgeville/Mineral Point, Pecatonica/Argyle, Southwestern, Stockten-Warren

The purpose of this meet is to allow as many individuals as possible from each school to compete, rather than a team-oriented meet. The following guidelines will be followed.

- 1) The regular WIAA events, order of events, and rules for competition will be used, except in the number of entrants from each school. Each school can enter as many people in each individual event as they wish, but due to time, **please use good judgment for lane races and field events**. Each school can enter more than one relay team from their school.
- 2) Entries will be done online through directathletics.com. You can go to that website directly or go through our timing website accuracetiming.com. We must have times and distances for all athletes in all events. Entries are due by Monday April 22, 2019 at 10:00 AM. Due to the late deadline for entries there will be scratches only at the meet.
- 3) Competitors will use the gates at the **north (scoreboard) end** of the track to report to the Clerk of Course and to get to the throwing areas.
- 4) Only Competitors and officials are allowed inside the fence after the meet starts.
- 5) AWARDS-Medals will be given to the top three finishers in each event. A plaque will be awarded to the "Best Performance" male and female as decided by the games committee.
- 6) Trials will be held in the 100 meter dash ONLY AND WILL BE ADVANCING ON TIME ONLY. The other running events will be finals only.
- 7) The meet will start at 4:00 PM with the field events and the 100 meter dash trials. The rest of the running events will follow in normal order. Please note: The 4 x 800m relay will be run immediately after the 100m trials.
- 8) Boys will go first in the discus and pole vault. Girls will go first in the shot put and high jump. The long jump and triple jump will be open pit for the boys and girls from 4:00 to 6:00. The long jumpers use the east runway and the triple jumpers use the west runway. Due to the number of anticipated jumpers in the long and triple jump, jumpers will get three jumps and no finals. Shot put and discus will have three throws and no finals.
- 9) Starting height for the high jump is: Boys-4'10" and Girls-3'10". The starting height for the pole vault is Boys-7'0" and Girls-6'0".
