

GENERAL INFORMATION

DEERFIELD CLASSIC MAY 6th, 2016

Welcome to the 27th Deerfield Classic. We plan to have an outstanding meet featuring many of the state's top performers.

The following boys and girls teams are entered this year:

1. **ENTRIES:** We will be using athletic.net for entries this year.

ENTRIES WILL BE DUE – TUESDAY, May 3rd at 11:59 pm

Entries are the same as WIAA Regionals. You can enter 1 relay team per event and a total of 28 individuals spaced out over the 14 individual events with a maximum of 3 per event.

2. **CHANGES AND SCRATCHES:** Changes may be made until 8:00 pm on Wednesday, May 4th. **Scratches only after Wednesday night. CONTACT MATT TO MAKE CHANGES VIA EMAIL OR PHONE. DON'T GO BACK TO THE WEBSITE AFTER THE INITIAL DEADLINE.** I will send out preliminary heat sheets later on Wednesday and would be willing to make changes only if there is a legitimate mistake.
3. **AWARDS:** MEDALS: 1st - 8th places, all events
TROPHIES: Team - 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th, Boys and Girls
M.V.P. - Field and Track, Boys and Girls
MEDALS will be presented on the infield between events by former Deerfield Track and Field Athletes.
TROPHIES, Team and MVPs, will be presented at the conclusion of the meet.
4. **WEIGHT PERSONS 100M DASH:** Will follow the 1600M relay events. This will be for both boys and girls. *This event is not included in the team scoring and will not be awarded medals*
5. **TRIALS:** The top EIGHT (8) will go to the finals in the field events. Heat winners and next fastest times for a total of EIGHT (8) will advance to finals in the 100M Dash, 110M and 100M Hurdles. The 200M presents a problem on our SIX (6) lane track. The heat winners and next fastest times will advance to the finals to fill two heats (12 total) for finals.
6. **CONCESSIONS:** The Deerfield Track and Field Team will be running the concession stands, and a large variety of food will be available. We hope you will use our concessions rather than bring your own.

7. T-SHIRTS: Classic T-Shirts will be available at the meet.
8. TRACK SURFACE: The track is a sprint track. We can use 1/4" needle spikes or the round based Phillips spikes. Shot and Discus rings are concrete.
9. WEATHER: The ONLY thing that will prevent this meet from taking place is lightening, and we will try to wait that out. Wind, rain, and temperature have never stopped the meet.
11. SHOT/DISCUS **WE WILL HAVE A MINIMUM MEASUREMENT MARK!**
The number of teams and entries has created some problems with darkness, therefore the following distances are the minimum to be measured in both the shot put and the discus. **Girls Shot Put - 27' Girls Discus - 70'**
Boys Shot Put - 35' Boys Discus - 100'
***ALSO PLEASE NOTE-**We will run girls shot first and boys discus first! This will help with not having to measure boy's discus throws as it is starting to get dark as they generally are throwing farther than the girls.
12. ATHLETES: Please keep all non-competing athletes off the infield. Athletes should report to the clerk for heat/lane assignments as well as race instructions. The officials will not be giving instruction, they will just be starting the race.
13. ENTRY FEES: **\$80.00 boys, \$80.00 girls, \$160 both boys and girls**
Please send entry fee in advance or bring day of meet.
14. STARTING TIMES: 4:00 Field Events (Girls LJ, HJ,SP and Boys Disc, TJ, PV)
4:15 4 X 800 Relay (Girls first)
Then trials in the 100, 100/110 hurdles and 200
