Dear Coaches,

This letter will provide you with all of the necessary information about this year's Freshmen/Sophomore meet at Evansville High School on May 17th, 2018.

Participating teams: Albany, Beloit Turner, Big Foot, Brodhead, Clinton, East Troy, Edgerton, Evansville, Jefferson, McFarland, Milton, Parkview and Whitewater. Please check to see that the entry fee has been sent to Evansville.

General Meet Information

1. Entries should be done through <https://www.directathletics.com/> Entries will be open from Thursday, May 10 through Wednesday, May 16 at Noon.
2. The meet will be held on Thursday, May 17, with field events beginning at 4:00 pm; and running events at 4:30 pm. ***THERE WILL BE NO TRIALS, ALL EVENTS ARE FINAL.*** The **order of field events** will be; girls shot put, long jump, and high jump; boys' discus, triple jump, and pole-vault.
3. **It is extremely important** that you observe the deadline for data entry. **We will only accept scratches on Thursday, May 17th in the press box.**
4. The meet will be scored to 8 places. Medals for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd individual places. Team trophies will be awarded to the boys and girls 1st place teams.
5. **We will be allowing no more than 3 per event, plus relays.**
6. **Pole vault certification sheets must be provided before a competitor may vault.** We prefer that coaches fax their sheets to us ahead of time (608-882-6157). Regardless, teams must have them turned in before competition begins.
7. Spike length may not protrude more than 1/4" from the bottom of the sole.
8. Please supply all batons to the first runner in the relays.
9. **Check marks for long jump, triple jump, and pole vault must be off the runway.**

10. The check-in for all races will be at the clerk of course. Athletes must check in with the clerk of course or be scratched from competition.
11. All competitors will be required to warm-up outside the track area. Only those athletes currently competing will be allowed on the track. **Coaches are asked to remind athletes to stay off the infield.** Only high jumpers are allowed to be in the vicinity of their event on the infield.
