SEED MEETING

We will be hosting the sectional seed meeting on **Tuesday, May 19, 2015 at 6:10 p.m**. The meeting will be located at Northside College Prep High School, which is located at **5501 N. Kedzie** (the corner of Brwyn Mawr and Kedzie). There is a large parking lot in front of the school, and across the street from the school that you may park in. Villa Palmero Catering will provide Pasta and beverages for the Seed Meeting.

As sectional host, I am required to use the data provided to me by the IHSA office. You do not submit the list of participants to me, but through the IHSA's website. Please enter your participants for this sectional on ihsa.org at the school center. Please refer to your principal or athletic director for your school's respective log-in and password. **Per IHSA rules, entries** *must* **be entered by noon on May 18, 2015.** Once the deadline passes, any entries, or lack of entries, will become *official*. I would suggest printing a copy of your participant entries to bring to the seed meeting in case of any technical errors.

Likewise, although uncommon, challenges do occur at seed meetings, so it is wise to bring meet results that support any seed marks. It is no longer mandatory to attend the seed meeting, but is *highly recommended*, especially in case of any challenges that may arise.

MEET DAY

Attached you will find a schedule for the day of the meet. As always, it is approximate, and we will do our best to be as efficient as possible.

Please make arrangements now to ensure that you are on time for the beginning of the meet. Events will run *as scheduled*.

All implements will be weighed before the beginning of events. A games committee will be selected on the day of the seed meeting.

Worker Assignments

Per IHSA Terms and Conditions Item V-C-17, all participating schools are required to honor any request made by the host school relative to securing adequate help in conducting the sectional track and field meets. That being said, we are requesting one qualified adult worker to help in the running of field events and exchange zones. Our school will provide the rest in terms of additional exchange judges, and event officials. Please fax the attached sign up sheet by NOON on Monday, May 18, 2015. The worker preferences will be assigned on a first-come first-serve basis. Thanks.

Meet Scoring

Northside College Prep has contracted Clark Jillson of **AccuRace Timing Services** to provide F.A.T. timing for the Chicago Northside IHSA Sectional. Meet results will be available following the meet at: www.accuracetiming.com

AccuRace Timing is also the official timer for the Eric Nelson Track & Field Classic, William Penn University, the University of Wisconsin, Illinois State, Marquette University, Ashford University, University of Dubuque, Grand View University, North Central, Knox College, and Macalester College.

We will have prelims for the 100m dash, as well as the 200m and 110 hurdles (if needed). **The top 8 fastest times will qualify to the finals** (*not heat winners; please inform your athletes*). There will also be prelims for the field events (only if needed). In such a case, the top 9 of each field event will compete in the final, with distances carrying over in every event, except for high jump.

The top 6 competitors will score (scoring will be 10-8-6-4-2-1) and receive medals, in addition to all-sectional honors. A team plaque will be awarded to the IHSA Sectional Champion Team.

State Finals Advancement Procedures

To qualify an athlete down state, he needs to finish in either the top two competitors in his respective event, or, qualify by time/distance. There is no limit on the number of qualifiers in an event who may record the automatic qualifying mark.

Meet Admission Fee

There will be a mandatory admissions fee, as required by the IHSA. All parents, guardians, family and friends, as well as general spectators, will be required to pay in order to gain entrance in to the stadium, no exceptions. The admission fee is \$5.00. PLEASE inform your athletes ahead of time to share that information with their parents in order to avoid any confusion at the gate. The only people who will gain access to the stadium free of charge will be team members, coaches and two student managers per team.
