Entry Deadline: Final entries due Thursday, January 18, 2018, 11:00am

Entry Procedure: Entry procedure will be done with Direct Athletics. The entry procedure will be conducted online at www.directathletics.com. No open or unattached athletes.

Entry Standards: There are no entry standards in the running or field events. There are no limits to the number entries in each event or relay. Heats in all running events will run fast to slow. There will be 1 circle for the throws. Each competitor will be given four throws with no finals. Competitors in the long and triple jump events will be allowed four jumps with no finals and 15min will be given to competitors before flights in the throws and horizontal jumps for warm-ups. No more then 30min will be given for warm-ups in the vertical jumps. After reviewing entries, starting heights for HJ & PV will be set and sent by noon Friday.
Runner check-in will be at hip number table off turn one.

Seeding: Heats will be drawn by seed times. Lane assignment will be determined by seed times.

Preferred lanes: 60m & 60mH will be 2-3-1-4 & 300m 3-4-2-1

Entry Fee: \$200.00 per men/women team. \$400.00 for both.

Track Facility: The track is a 4-lane 200m Mondo surface. All field event areas are also Mondo. Only **1/4" pyramid spike** elements may be used. The Long Jump/Triple Jump & Pole Vault runways are each over 150' long. Long Jump has a true board at 11 feet from the pit, which is 20 feet long. Triple Jump boards are painted at 28, 32, 36, 40, 44 feet from the pit. High Jump approach is 20' wide on each side and 75' deep. The shot and weight circles are wood.

Doors will open at 8:30am.

Throws Weigh In: All throwing implements will be weighed in at the weigh in table starting at 9:00am.

Scoring: Separate as well as combined Men's & Women's dual scoring will be used. Only the top two from each school will score in individual events and only one relay team will score. Scoring will be 5, 3, 2, 1 for individual events and 5, 3 for relays.
