Change of Meet Location:

This season we will run the meet at Beloit College's Strong Memorial Stadium Complex. The complex is only 6 miles north of Hononegah. Take 251 north (becomes 51 in Wisconsin), turn right on East Grand Ave., turn right on Wisconsin Ave., turn right on Bushnell St., turn right on Chapin St.

New Time Schedule:

We will use the IHSA format and have no running prelims. Field events will start at 5:00 p.m., and running finals will begin at 6:00 p.m. Scratches, Weigh-Ins begin at 4:00, coaches meeting 4:30.

Competition

Each team will enter **two** varsity athletes and **one** frosh-soph athlete in the individual events. Relays will be run at the varsity level. Fresh-Soph participants can compete in varsity events but must follow the four event rule.

New Event

Since there will not be any prelims we will run an all-comers 1600 meter for any athlete that is not competing in other events. There are no restrictions for the amount of athletes a team can enter, just keep it within reason.

Entries

All entries will be made online at www.directathletics.com. All times that are not entered as an F.A.T. time need to be rounded by 0.24 by NFHS rules. Please make these changes to all hand times. AccuRace Timing Services will be used for the timing of the meet. Entries are closed on Wednesday, May 4, 5:00 p.m. There will be no substitutions, only scratches on the day of the meet.
