*** Coaches please note the Platteville Jr. High Open. Please advise your Jr. High programs of the race. It is open to any runner, 8th grade or under. The distance will be 1.5 miles. There is No entry fee, No team scores will be kept. Times will be recorded. Trophy for the 1st place male and female finisher, and ribbons to all finishers. Your MS programs are not being contacted other than this mailing.**

**** NOTICE:** All teams in the High School Races will run together. Teams will then be separated into small and large divisions for team scoring and for all awards in the VARSITY COMPETITION ONLY.

*In the four Varsity Races run seven and count five. In the two Junior Varsity Races, there is unlimited entries, and your first five runners will be your counters.

In the **Open Race**, no team scores or times will be kept. We will have a large Race Clock to aid the athletes and coaches in obtaining times. There is also **no** entry fee.

Awards:

Varsity Divisions: 1st and 2nd place Team trophies in each Varsity Division (**large and small**) as well as **Medals for the top seven runners** on each divisional championship team. **Individual Trophy for 1st place** finisher. **Medals 2nd through 10th. Ribbons 11th through 30th** in EACH division.

Junior Varsity Divisions: 1st and 2nd place Team trophies. Trophy for 1st Place finisher, Medals 2nd through 10th. Ribbons 11-40th. (Ribbons handed out to runners as they finish)

“Fastest Freshmen” Trophy to the best time of the Freshmen Girl and Freshmen Boy finisher in the competitions.

Junior High Open: 1st Place Trophy to the top girl and boy finisher. Ribbons to all finishers.

- Be reminded that the course is located at the UWP VETERANS MEMORIAL PARK -
- Course Maps will be mailed out at a later date.
- There will be Port-o-Potties available by the Start of the Race

* A Trainer will be available at the meet.

Medical Emergencies will be handled through Southwest Health Services.

*Athletes should stay within 6’ of any blue flags.

*Remind your athletes about all WIAA rules concerning conduct and clothing.

*The meet will be computer scored again this year through Direct Athletics. Athletes will be wearing bib numbers, and will receive them the day of the meet.

Bus Parking and General Parking:

+Buses and team vans may park in the lower parking lot near the start/finish. All Spectators will need to park in the upper parking lots. OR, in the Parking area that is SouthWest of the Limestone Loop. See Map.

Team Tent Set Up:

+Tents should **NOT** be set up anywhere in the middle of the course where the Start and Finish run through. Tents may be set up to the South of the start area, or any where that is to the outside of the course. If there is a problem, we would appreciate your teams cooperation in moving if need be.

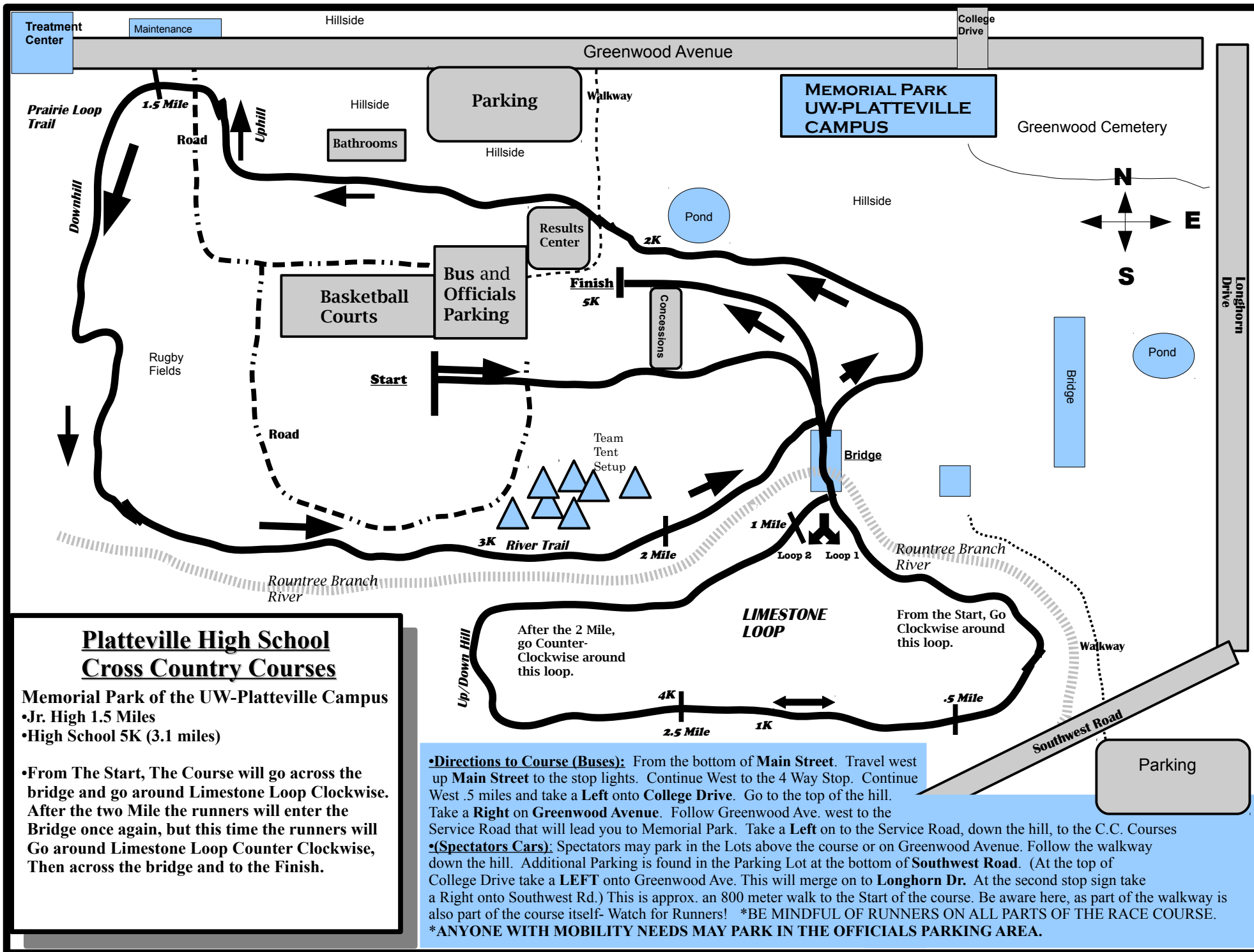

Platteville High School Cross Country Courses

Memorial Park of the UW-Platteville Campus

- Jr. High 1.5 Miles
- High School 5K (3.1 miles)

•From The Start, The Course will go across the bridge and go around Limestone Loop Clockwise. After the two Mile the runners will enter the Bridge once again, but this time the runners will Go around Limestone Loop Counter Clockwise, Then across the bridge and to the Finish.

•**Directions to Course (Buses):** From the bottom of Main Street. Travel west up Main Street to the stop lights. Continue West to the 4 Way Stop. Continue West .5 miles and take a Left onto College Drive. Go to the top of the hill. Take a Right on Greenwood Avenue. Follow Greenwood Ave. west to the Service Road that will lead you to Memorial Park. Take a Left on to the Service Road, down the hill, to the C.C. Courses

•**(Spectators Cars):** Spectators may park in the Lots above the course or on Greenwood Avenue. Follow the walkway down the hill. Additional Parking is found in the Parking Lot at the bottom of Southwest Road. (At the top of College Drive take a LEFT onto Greenwood Ave. This will merge on to Longhorn Dr. At the second stop sign take a Right onto Southwest Rd.) This is approx. an 800 meter walk to the Start of the course. Be aware here, as part of the walkway is also part of the course itself- Watch for Runners! *BE MINDFUL OF RUNNERS ON ALL PARTS OF THE RACE COURSE. *ANYONE WITH MOBILITY NEEDS MAY PARK IN THE OFFICIALS PARKING AREA.
