Location: Ryan Zimpel Memorial Cross-Country Course

Directions: Take the one-way street (Brindley Street) in front of Boscobel High School all the way to the stop sign. Turn right at the stop sign on Chestnut Street. Follow Chestnut and it will turn into Riley Road. It will take you out of town three miles and the Zimpel farm will be on the right side of the road. Watch for signs.

From Fennimore: If you are traveling North on Hwy. 61 it will not be necessary to come all the way to Boscobel. Take Hwy. 61 North out of Fennimore for approximately 3.5 miles and turn right on Cty. T. You will stay on Cty. T for 2.9 miles, then turn left on Riley Road. Stay on Riley for two miles and the Zimpel farm will be on the left. Watch for signs.

High School Awards:

Individual: Plaque to the winner of each race (4) Medals for 2nd through 10th in each race (36) Ribbons for 11th through 20th in each race (40) Participation ribbons to all other runners

Race Times: 4:15 – Girls race (5K) – jv and varsity will run together

4:50 – Boys race (5K)– jv and varsity will run together

5:15 – 7th grade girls race 5:30 – 8th grade girls race 5:45 – 7th grade boys race 6:00 – 8th grade boys race

Entry Fee: \$130 per school for middle and high school.

\$100 per school if only participating in high school race. \$50 per school if only participating in the middle school race.
