**Williams Fieldhouse**

- Teams Attending: Argyle/Pecatonica, Benton/Scales Mound/Shullsburg, Boscobel, Darlington, Dodgeville/Mineral Point, Fennimore, Lancaster, Monroe, Oregon, Platteville and Prairie du Chien
- Entry Limits: Teams will be limited to 3 athletes per event, and one relay entry per event. Wisconsin high school rules apply to the number of events an individual athlete competes in.
- Entry Fee: Entry fee is \$300.00 per school or \$150.00 per single gender team. Credit card payment will be required when you finalize your entries. - Entry Deadline: **wi.milesplit.com** will be handling online entries. Only online entries will be accepted. Registration will begin on **Sunday, March 15<sup>th</sup>**. Online entries will close at **Noon on Tuesday, March 24<sup>th</sup>**. - Start Time: Depending on the weather and UW-Platteville athletic needs, the indoor track won't be available until 4:45 pm. Coaches meeting will be in B52 which is on the lower level as you enter the track. This meeting will take place at 4:45 pm.
- Performances: Please submit realistic times for all track entries. Races 200m and above will be seeded from slowest to fastest. Only scratches and substitutions will be accepted the day of the meet. This will take place at the coaches meeting.
- Pole Vault Verification Form: All schools must supply a pole vault verification form at check-in. This form is located at the following web site:

- Facility: The meet will take place in the Williams Fieldhouse at UW-Platteville. The track is 6 lanes (8 lanes on the straight) with a Rekortan surface. Spikes will be allowed but can only be 1/8 inch. Team camps will be in racquetball courts and the pool balcony when you arrive. Shoes with spikes in them should only be worn in the competition area. **Athletes should not bring sugary liquids onto the competition area.**
- Long Jump: The long jump will only use the South Pit (Garage Door). Distance from the wood takeoff board is 10 feet. Approach is approximately 115 feet. There is also a painted surface board that is five feet from pit if needed.
- Triple Jump: The triple jump will only use the West Pit (Back Stretch). Distances from the track surface takeoff boards are 24, 28, 32, 36, and 40 feet. Approach is unlimited.
- Locker Rooms: Locker rooms and showers are located one flight above the track level in the men and women's general locker room. Please provide your own locks and towels. No items should be left unattended in the locker rooms.
- Training Room: A certified trainer will be available throughout the entire event. The trainers will be located on the north side of the track.
- Bus Parking: Buses may drop off athletes/coaches in the circle drive area on the East side of the Williams Fieldhouse. Bus parking will be in Lot 6.

Gate Information: The gate costs are \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students. Concessions will be available.

Waiver Form: **Athletes and coaches should be aware and in compliance with paperwork necessary to compete at UW-Platteville. This form will cover your entire team and will be forwarded to the head coach a month or so before the meet. It must be sent to Chris Rotzenberg (rotzenbergc@uwplatt.edu) no later than three days before the meet. If your team competed at the Fri or Sat meet earlier this week, you don't have to submit the form again.**
