To: West Relays Division A & B Boys Track Coaches

Dear Coach,

We are getting ready for the 78TH running of the Madison West Relays. The meet will be held Saturday April 4 at the Camp Randall Sports Center (The Shell) on the UW-Madison campus. Your bus can drop the athletes off on Monroe Street in front of the building. There is no parking lot for the buses. The bus drivers will need to find a place to park on their own. Parents and fans may park in the parking ramp to the north of The Shell as well as the lots several blocks away east of The Shell. Admission to the meet will be \$5.00 for adults and \$3.00 for students/children. Please note that the **200 meter dash will be a timed final**. Also note that the **Pole Vault will make use of the mandated collar on the vault box**. The Division B meet will start at 10:00am. The Division A meet will start at 4:30pm. There are restrooms but no locker or shower facilities. Athletes should come dressed to compete. Please note that two **(2) entries will be allowed in the field events, the 55 M. Dash and the 55M. High Hurdles. All other events will be limited to one (1) entry per school**. Any additional entries will automatically be scratched. Coaches should make their entries carefully. Changes will be allowed at the meet, but we want to keep these to a minimum.

Opening Heights – Pole Vault 10' 6 (B), 11' 6(A), High Jump 5' 6" (B), 5' 6" (A)

Minimum to measure – Long Jump 18' (B), 19' (A). Shot Put 42' (B), 44' (A)

Coaches must submit their meet entries using the DirectAthletics on-line entry system (www.directathletics.com)

Paper, faxed or other form of entries will NOT be accepted. Coaches can search for the meet by date or by name. Coaches should be sure that they either already have DirectAthletics log-in or that they create one.

Coaches may begin submitting entries Monday March 16, 2015. Entries are due by 11:59pm PM CST Saturday March 28, 2014. Failure to adhere to this deadline may result in withdrawal from the meet. The online entry system will NOT be turned back on after it closes. Coaches are accountable for submitting entries on time. Please put a reminder in your calendaring software, iPhone, post-it notes, etc. to remind you. Make sure Madison West High School has your contact information (email, work phone, home phone, cell phone) so they can contact you if there are issues with your entries (i.e. you forget to submit your entries).
