WIAA SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

Field Events

All Field Events will begin at 3:00 pm

- Shot Put: Girls followed by Boys Flights; 3 throws; best 9 to finals
- Long Jump: Girls followed by Boys Prelims are 60 min Open pit; 3 jumps; best 9 to finals(1-1-1)
- High Jump; Girls followed by Boys Five Alive
- Triple Jump: Boys followed by Girls Prelims are 60 min Open pit; 3 jumps; best 9 to finals(1-1-1)
- Pole Vault; Boys followed by Girls Five Alive
- Discus: Boys followed by Girls Flights; 3 throws; best 9 to finals
- Starting heights for pole vault and high jump will be set two increments below the 8th best athlete. Starting height in high jump must be at an even increment, raised 2" until 6 competitors remain; then a 1" increment. Starting height in pole vault must be at a 6" or 12" increment, raised 6" until 6 competitors remain; then a 3" increment.
- Wheelchair Shot Put competes with the appropriate gender.

Running Events-All running events will be girls followed by boys, wheelchair events are coed.
