### FACILITY:

- 8-lane Seal-Flex track
- shot and discus pads are located on the south side of the track
- high jump located in the infield
- long jump, triple jump, pole vault are located north-east of the track
- 1/4" pyramid spikes allowed for the track, approaches, and runways
- Buses can drop athletes off at the Grant County Fairgrounds next to the track and park at the fairgrounds, all other vehicles will be able to park in designated parking areas at the school
- Coaches and athletes are not to be on the grass infield. There will be roped off areas for coaches at the field event areas. Coaches will need to wear a pass to enter these areas (Passes furnished in your packets upon arrival)
- Concessions will be available on the grounds, and we'll be selling sectional meet t-shirts as well.
- Admission = \$5 (no charge for children under 5).

**FIELD EVENTS:**

- Field events begin at **3:30pm** with the girls starting in High Jump, Long Jump, and Shot Put, and boys starting in Pole Vault, Triple Jump, and Discus.
- We will have flights in Shot Put and Discus
- Long Jump and Triple Jump events will be open pit for 1 hour with the top 9 qualifying for finals.
- We'll run a "five alive" continuing flight procedure for High Jump and Pole Vault.
- Warm-up throws and run-throughs are allowed before the start of competition as long as the field event judge is present. Warm-up throws and run-throughs are allowed between flights for 10 minutes. After trials have been completed, another 10 minutes of warm-up throws or run-throughs are allowed before finals begin.
- If a competitor needs to compete in another event, he/she must notify the field event judge before leaving, and then is allowed 15 minutes to report back to conclude his/her competition.

**RUNNING EVENTS:**

- Running events begin at **4:15pm** with the 4x800m relay finals, followed by the trials of the 100m dash, 100/110m high hurdles, and 200m dash. After a 15 minute break, finals will begin with the 100/110m high hurdles.
- Athletes are encouraged to report to the Clerk of Course before the second call. We will not wait for athletes to check in after the third call has been made.
- Starting blocks will be provided.
