ENTRIES:

Entry Deadline – Friday, May 19th, 2017 at 8:00am. All entries will be done on-line through PTTiming. Detailed instructions for submitting entries are posted on the WIAA website. Coaches attempting to enter after the deadline will not be able to access the PTTiming entry site. As per WIAA Season Regulations: "Schools submitting forms after the deadline date or time will be permitted to compete, but will not receive consideration for seeds, lanes, heats, sections, etc." It will be the Regional Hosts responsibility to determine the format in which late entries will be submitted. Regional hosts will download the regional meet, already seeded directly from PTTiming into their Hy-Tek program.

A school may enter a maximum of:

- One entry in each relay event (maximum of six students listed).
- 28 individual event entries.
- There is a maximum limit of three in any individual event.
- Each individual may have four total events with no more than three field events or three running events (being listed as an alternate counts as an event).

THROWS:

- Weigh-ins for shots and discus will be by the throws area.
- There will be three throws allowed in trials, 9 competitors will move to finals for another three throws.
- There will be 10 minutes of warm-ups between trials and finals.

LONG & TRIPLE JUMPS:

- Open Pit will be used for trials.
- There will be three jumps allowed in trials, 9 competitors will move to finals for another three jumps.
- There will be 10 minutes of warm-ups between trials and finals.

HIGH JUMP & POLE VAULT:

- Starting heights in the Pole Vault and High Jump will be determined by counting down two heights, using the seed performance of the 8th seeded competitor (1' in PV & 4" in HJ).
- The HJ bar must be raised two inches each time until six competitors remain. The bar thereafter will be raised by one inch.
- The PV bar must be raised six inches each time until six competitors remain. The bar thereafter will be raised three inches each time.

COMPETITION:

- Competitors excused to compete in another event have a maximum of 15 minutes. The time starts when the athlete's name is called for their next attempt.
- Time Rules will be enforced:
 - Shot Put, Discus, Long Jump & Triple Jump – 1 minute to complete trial
 - High Jump & Pole Vault – 1 minute to complete trial, then up to 3 minutes when 2-3 competitors remain, and up to 5 minutes when only one competitor remains
- 1/8" & 1/4" spikes will be allowed for all running and jumping events – as long as only 1/8" is exposed. Shot put and discus pads are concrete, so rubber soled shoes are necessary.
- There will be designated coaches boxes in the field event areas.
- If you wish to have a decision reviewed by the Jury of Appeals, please contact a Meet Official.

GENERAL INFORMATION:

- MHS track is located next to the Marshall Middle School. Address is: 401 School St. Marshall, WI
- Tents should be set up outside of the track.
- Bus parking will be located in either the ELC School parking lot, which is just northeast of the Track, off William Street, or in the Elementary School parking lot, which is just west of the Track.
- There will be concessions available during the meet.
- Regional T-shirts will be available for purchase for \$10.
- Admission charge for spectators will be \$5.00. Children under 10 years old are free.
- Absolutely **NO SPECTATORS** will be allowed on the infield before, during, or after the meet. There are asphalt walkways around the track they may use.
