FACILITY:

- 8-lane all-weather track located behind McFarland High School (note athletes will be dropped off on Exchange Street – See Site map)
- All field events located within the fenced area of the track and field facility (See Site map).
- 1/4" pyramid spikes (no pins allowed)
- Bus Drivers – Please drop off coaches and athletes at the designated drop off site on Exchange Street. There will be a greeter there to direct you. Buses will need to leave that area and return to Indian Mound Middle school after 3:40 p.m.
- Buses should park in the middle school designated parking area once available at approximately 3:45 p.m. (See Site Map)
- In case of inclement weather athletes/spectators will be directed to the nearest Emergency Shelter Areas located in the middle school and in the high school. (See Site Map)
- Tents should be set up in the warm up area, below the Indian Mound Middle School.
- Handicapped parking is available in the middle school parking lot (6330 Exchange Street).
- Coaches will only be allowed in designated coaching areas.
- Concessions will be available underneath the press box.
- Participants and Spectators can purchase sectional meet t-shirts located behind the press box.
- Spectators: Admission = \$5, Heat Sheets will be sold for \$1(no charge for children under 5).

- Plaques for first place boys and girls teams will be presented at the conclusion of the meet.
- Medals for the first 4 individuals/relays will be presented in the infield. Coaches please remind your athletes to listen for their event results and when to report to the infield for recognition. We will do our best to announce the top 4 finishers in a timely manner.

FIELD EVENTS:

- Field events begin at **3:45 pm**.

Boys – Pole Vault	Girls – High Jump
Boys – Discus	Girls – Shot
Boys – Triple Jump	Girls – Long Jump
- Weigh-in of implements will be done in the shed next to the discus area.
- There will be flights in Shot Put and Discus.
- Long Jump and Triple Jump prelims will be open pit for 1 hour. The top 9 will advance to finals.
- A "five alive" continuing flight procedure will be used for High Jump and Pole Vault.
- Warm-up throws and run-throughs are allowed before the start of competition as long as the field event judge is present. Warm-up throws are allowed between flights for 15 minutes. After trials have been completed, another 10 minutes of warm-up throws or run-throughs are allowed before finals begin.
- If a competitor needs to compete in another event, he/she must notify the field event judge before leaving, and then is allowed 15 minutes (after name is called to begin their attempt) to report back to conclude his/her competition.

RUNNING EVENTS:

- Running events begin at **4:30pm** with the 4x800m relay finals, followed by the trials of the 100m dash, 100/110m high hurdles, and 200m dash. After a 15 minute break, finals will begin with the 100/110m high hurdles.
- Athletes must report to the Clerk of Course before the second call. We will not wait for athletes to check in after the third call has been made.
- There will be starting blocks available. If you bring your own, they need to meet rubber track specifications.
