Bus and General Parking:

Buses and/or Team Vans and Race Officials may park in the lower parking lot near the start/finish. All other spectators will need to park in the upper parking lots. OR, in the new Parking area that is SouthWest of the Limestone Loop.

Team Tent Set Up:

Tents should <u>NOT</u> be set up anywhere in the middle of the course where the Start and Finish run through. Tents may be set up to the South of the start area, or any area that is to the outside of the course. If there is a problem, we would appreciate your teams cooperation in moving if need be. See Map.

Restricted Areas:

Coaches and athletes are restricted from the information building where results will be processed. Coaches may enter this area to make changes or in picking up their packets before the meet. The finish and chute area are also considered restricted. Please allow our workers to do their jobs effectively.

Results:

Results will be available immediately following the Awards Ceremony. Results can be found on line shortly after the meet at: pttiming.com

Awards:

Plaques to the Runner-Up and Championship Teams. Medals to Members (7) of the runner-up and championship teams. Medals to first five individuals who are not members of a qualifying team. These plaque and medal winners will also advance on to the WIAA State Cross Country Meet.

Awards Presentation:

The Awards presentation will take place on site by the Basketball Courts. If we have inclement weather, the awards presentation will take place at Platteville High School Gymnasium. Directions to the HS will be provided to Teams and Spectators on site as needed. We ask that all athletes upon receiving awards are wearing proper school issued attire. No hats, nor clothing that is deemed unacceptable by the Meet Manager. Thank you for your help with this. We also request that all teams stay for the awards to show respect for those teams and individuals that have qualified and respect for the great sport of Cross Country.

Publishing:

A Publishing Company is producing the program for our Cross Country Sectional, they will be contacting you about your teams rosters and team pictures.

Medical:

Platteville High School will have a Trainer on site for any medical emergencies. Southwest Health Center is our local Hospital for any severe emergencies.

Lead and Trail Vehicles:

There will be a Lead Vehicle to guide the lead runners through the course. A trail vehicle may also be in use for any athletes that may become injured or incapacitated during the race.

Race Numbers and Tags:

NUMBERS will be worn by each of the athletes. These Numbers should be worn on the Front of the jersey's.

Concessions:

Concessions will be available in the pavilion, which is located next to the finish area.

T-Shirts:

A commemorative Long Sleeve T-Shirt will be available for ~\$20.00. This is sure to be a classic!!! No pre-orders need to be sent in before the meet. Supplies may be limited however. Have your athletes get them early.

Directions to Veterans Memorial Park, UW - Platteville, Platteville WI.

Entering Platteville from Hwy 151 North:

Take Exit <u>US-151 Business</u> into Platteville. You will enter by the Super WalMart and Menards.

Follow 151-Dubuque Rd. to Hwy 80/81 (WalGreens is on your right). Take a RIGHT at the Stoplights.

You are now on Hwy 80/81-Water Street. Go through the next stoplight and 1 block to MAIN ST.

Take a LEFT onto MAIN ST.

Follow Main St. through Downtown to College Drive. (This will be approx. 1 mile)

Take a LEFT on COLLEGE DRIVE.

At the top of College Drive, take a RIGHT on to GREENWOOD AVE. (may also be called Evergreen Ave.)

***(Parents may park in the lots above the course and use the walkway to the course)

Take a LEFT on Circle Drive to the Course.

Entering Platteville from Hwy 151 South:

Take Exit 18 into Platteville.

Follow 151-County Hwy D to Hwy 80/81 (Dairy Queen is on your left). Take a LEFT at the Stoplights.

You are now on Hwy 80/81-Water Street. Go through the next stoplight and 1 block to MAIN ST.

Take a LEFT onto MAIN ST.

Follow Main St. through Downtown to College Drive. (This will be approx. 1 mile)

Take a LEFT on COLLEGE DRIVE.

At the top of College Drive, take a RIGHT on to GREENWOOD AVE. (may also be called Evergreen Ave.)

***(Parents may park in the lots above the course and use the walkway to the course)

Take a LEFT on Circle Drive to the Course.

Entering Platteville from Hwy 80 North:

Follow Hwy 80 North into Platteville.

You are now on Hwy 80/81-Water Street.

Take a Right onto MAIN ST.

Follow Main St. through Downtown to College Drive. (This will be approx. 1 mile)

Take a LEFT on COLLEGE DRIVE.

At the top of College Drive, take a RIGHT on to GREENWOOD AVE. (may also be called Evergreen Ave.)

***(Parents may park in the lots above the course and use the walkway to the course)

Take a LEFT on Circle Drive to the Course.

Entering Platteville from Hwy 81 North:

Follow Hwy 81 into Platteville.

Continue to follow Hwy 81 to Main St.

Take a Right onto MAIN ST.

Follow Main St. to College Drive. (This will be approx. .75 miles)

Take a LEFT on COLLEGE DRIVE.

At the top of College Drive, take a RIGHT on to GREENWOOD AVE. (may also be called Evergreen Ave.)

***(Parents may park in the lots above the course and use the walkway to the course)

Take a LEFT on Circle Drive to the Course.

Entering Platteville from Hwy 80/81 South:

Follow Hwy 80/81 into Platteville.

Continue to follow Hwy 80/81 to Main St.

Take a LEFT onto MAIN ST.

Follow Main St. through Downtown to College Drive. (This will be approx. 1 mile)

Take a LEFT on COLLEGE DRIVE.

At the top of College Drive, take a RIGHT on to GREENWOOD AVE. (may also be called Evergreen Ave.)

***(Parents may park in the lots above the course and use the walkway to the course)

Take a LEFT on Circle Drive to the Course.

- 1. Leaving the Race Site, enter on to Greenwood Avenue.
- 2. Take a **Left** Turn on to **College Drive.**
- 3. At the Stop Sign, turn **Right** on to **Main St.**
- 4. Follow Main St. approximately 1 mile to the bottom of Main.
- 5. At the bottom of Main, take a Left on to Water St.
- 6. Proceed North on Water St. for approx. 1 mile until you get to **Madison St.**
- 7. Take a **Right** on **Madison St.**, the High School is on your Left at the top of the hill.
