## Field Events:

Long & Triple Jump –3 jumps, no finals

High Jump – Starting height Girls – 3'0" Boys – 3'8"

Shot & Disc –3 throws, no finals - athletes will be able to make multiple throws.

Discus is located across the footbridge to the east of the track on the other side of the cemetery.

Bathrooms are currently not accessible. We will have port-a-potties available.

Concessions will be available on the back side of the little shed on the northwest side of the track.
