

# Sauk Prairie Track and Field Badger Small Conference Meet Thursday, May 22, 2025

**Teams participating:** Baraboo, Madison Edgewood, McFarland, Mount Horeb, Portage, Reedsburg Area, Sauk Prairie, and Stoughton

Sauk Prairie High School is pleased to host the Badger Small Conference Track and Field Meet on Thursday, May 22. The meet will be held at the Sauk Prairie Stadium located at Sauk Prairie High School, 105 9th Street, Prairie du Sac. Field events will begin at 3:00 pm and the running events will start at 4:30 pm.

**Entries:** Entries will be completed through Milesplit.com <a href="here">here</a> and are due by 12:00 pm Wednesday, May 21. For Varsity, each team may have 30 individual entries and 1 relay per school, per event. For JV, each team may have 30 individual entries and 1 relay per school/per event. An athlete can be entered as a Varsity athlete in one event and JV in another, as long as it does not exceed the 4 event maximum.

Badger Conf Bylaws: An athlete cannot compete in any more than 4 events combined between the Varsity and JV Conference meet.

## **Timing Company and Results:**

Accurace Timing will be timing the meet. **They will provide live results at** <u>accuracetiming.com</u>

Hip numbers will be required for all individual racers and for the anchor runners of each relay. Numbers will go on the left hip and left shoulder.

**Bus Drop-Off/Parking:** Athletes and coaches should be dropped off by the main entrance on the north side of the stadium, which is at the corner of 13th Street and Grand Avenue. Buses will be able to park along 13th Street. **There will not be any other entrance for athletes or spectators.** 

**Locker rooms:** Locker rooms will not be available but there will be bathrooms near the concession stand. Please have your athletes dressed and ready to compete.

**Admission:** All team members, coaches and managers will be admitted at no charge through the main gate. All tickets will be digital and sold at this link: <u>gofan</u> Please communicate this information to your families and spectators. No cash sales at the meet.

## Concessions: Are all cashless and only accept cards.

#### **Appeals Process:**

**Implement Check-In**: Implement check-in will begin at 2:15 pm in team room #1 located right behind the concession stand.

#### **Team Tents:**

Teams will be able to set up tents and camp areas in the grass to the north of the concession stand.

**Athletic Trainer**: An athletic trainer, from Sauk Prairie Healthcare, will be located near the finish line.

**Restrooms**: Restrooms are located at the north end of the stadium, right next to the concession stand.

**Restricted Areas:** Please be aware of and respect all restricted areas. These include the infield of the track, the press box, the start and finish line areas, and all flagged areas around the field events. Coaches boxes will be clearly marked near the field events. Only coaches of the event will be allowed in the coaches box. No spectators should be inside the fence around the track and not hanging out at events inside restricted areas such as the high jump or pole vault.

Spike Length and Track Markings: ¼ inch pyramid spikes are the only allowable spike length and type on our track surface. No tape is allowed for markings anywhere on the track or runway surfaces. Chalk will be provided at all of those locations.

**Sauk Prairie's Stadium:** The track runs north-south. The shot put and discus area are located in the northwest corner. The high jump is at the south end of the infield. The pole vault, long jump and triple jump are located in the southwest corner of the stadium.



**Relay Exchange Zones:** A Sauk Prairie Representative will be at each exchange zone for the 4 x 200m Relay and the 4 x 100m Relay. Assistance is requested from each team to ensure that all lanes are appropriately judged.

Field Events:

Will start at 3:00 pm.

All of the horizontal jumps and the throws will be in flights. There will be 30 minutes between the conclusion and start of the other gender in all field events. Each athlete will receive 3 throws/jumps. Varsity flights will happen first, with JV to follow. After the JV flights have concluded, there will be 15 minutes and then the Varsity Finals will begin in reverse order.

For the pole vault and high jump, JV athletes will be able to start at the lowest height, but must take all 3 attempts consecutively. All varsity athletes must come in at the tournament procedure starting heights-take the 8th best seed mark and drop two increments. Five alive will be used once the height is reached for the start of the varsity competition regardless if there are any JV athletes remaining.

Event checkout for athletes competing in another event will be 15 minutes. The event judge will record check out times when the athlete's turn in rotation is up and they notify the event judge of their check out. Check out is required in the long and triple jump finals along with the shot put and discus finals.

Medals to 1st, 2nd and 3rd place. Team trophies will be awarded to the Girls and Boys team champions.

Scoring for all Varsity events will be 10-8-6-5-4-3-2-1

All clerking and hip numbers will be handled in the northwest corner, by the 100m Start.
