Time: Coaches meeting will be held at 3:45 at the start finish line, field events begin at 4:00 and running events at 4:45. *Events will be on a rolling schedule.*

Facility: Meet will be held at the **Melrose-Mindoro** athletic facilities. Rubberized track surface and jumping facilities. CHALK ONLY-no tape for markings

Concessions: Available at the building between the track and baseball fields.

Spikes: ¼ inch spikes

Scoring: All events will be scored as follows 10-8-6-4-3-2-1 (Individual) 10-8-6-4-3-2-1 (relay).

Awards: All-conference awards to be passed out at the conclusion of the meet.

Implement weigh-in - will be under the press booth

Handoffs – 2 per exchange zone. 4x100: Augusta, Blair-Taylor, Cochrane Fountain City, Eau Claire Immanuel Lutheran, Lincoln, Eleva-Strum. 4x200: Whitehall, Independence/Gilmanton, Alma-Pepin.

Team Camps - Team Camps are to be set up in the area West of concessions and South of shot—NOT in the concession area.

Shot Put and Discus - 3 throws for prelims, 3 finals (9 qualifying throwers)

- -Boys Discus, followed by Girls
- Girls Shot, followed by Boys

Long and Triple Jump - 3 jumps for prelims, 3 finals (9 qualifying jumpers) jumps must be completed by 5:15 – finals to follow after with a 15 minute warmup

- -Girls Long Jump, followed by Boys Jumps must be completed by 5:15 finals to follow after
- Boys Triple Jump, followed by Girls **Jumps must be completed by 5:15 finals to follow after** Girls and Boys Pole Vault (starting height determined at coaches meeting.)
- Boys Pole Vault, followed by Girls
