Preliminaries: Preliminaries will be run in the 100M and 100/110 High Hurdles, unless there are no more entries than lanes allow. The winner of each heat advances to finals, with lanes filled with the next fastest times. There will be a 15 minute break following trials.

Field events: Field events will be run in flights, beginning at 4:00 pm. Check out time will be 10 minutes. The top eight performances in shot put, discus, long jump and triple jump will advance to finals. A ten minute warm up time will proceed to finals.

Scoring: 10-8-6-4-2-1 for individual events, 10-8-6-4-2 for relays.

Awards: Medals for 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> places, team plaque picture for 1<sup>st</sup> place teams immediately following results Coaches will vote (one vote for each head coach) on an outstanding male and female performer. In case of a tie, the athlete scoring the most points in the meet shall be declared the medal recipient. The award is for performances at the Conference Meet.
