	Shot and discus pads are located north of track.
	High jump located in the infield.
	All other field events located within the fenced area on the east side of the track.
	1/4" pyramid spikes allowed for the track, approaches, and runways.
?	Bus Parking: Please instruct drivers to park in the Northern section of the stadium or along Ben
	Lawton Drive near the stadium parking lot. This will ensure athletes have quick access to shelter in the event of a storm.
	Coaching boxes will be provided. Only athletes competing allowed on the infield.
	Athletic trainer will be on the south-end of the infield near the finish line.
	Concessions will be available.
	Tent area will be to the north of the track and field parking lot (toward the high school).
	Admission (Child/Student/Adult) = \$6 (plus fees for digital tickets). Cash and electronic tickets

	?	We will have flights in Shot Put and Discus events with the top 9 qualifying for finals.
		Implements must be weighed between 2:45 PM and 3:30 PM.
		Long jump and Triple jump prelims. will be cafeteria style by gender for 1.5 hrs, then top 9 to
		finals. If all competing athletes complete their jumps before the 1.5 hour time limit, we will
		move ahead with finals.
		We'll run a "five alive" continuing flight procedure for High Jump and Pole Vault.
		Warm-up throws and run-throughs are allowed before the start of competition as long as the field
		event judge is present. Warm-up throws and run-throughs are allowed between flights for 10 minutes. After trials have been completed, another 10 minutes of warm-up throws or run-throughs
		are allowed before finals begin.
	П	If a competitor needs to compete in another event, he/she must notify the field event judge before
		leaving, and then is allowed 15 minutes to report back to conclude his/her competition.
